GIŻYCKO AIR SHOW PRELUDE

31 August Thursday 19.00 - 21.00 | city beach

We invite you to the air show, which is a prelude to the Giżycko Air Show - of next year's!

A new aviation event is coming soon to Giżycko - the Giżycko Air Show, which is a prelude to next year's show in the heart of the Masuria region. This year we invite all aviation fans on 31 August 2023 to the town beach in Giżycko, from where it will be possible to observe the air show with the participation of crews from Poland and abroad. The event is hosted by the city of Giżycko. The show will be prepared in cooperation with the association Grupa Falco 2, which has taken up the challenge and is going to prepare us an aerial feast at the end of the summer holidays!

The framework programme of the show:

- 19.00 - 20.00 daytime block of shows
- 20.15 - 21.00 night show block

From 3 p.m. to 8 p.m., sightseeing flights in a helicopter and a tethered hot-air balloon are also available for a fee.

We give away some of the secrets and present the show groups that are going to perform in Giżycko:

Sky Magic - these are people with positive attitude to life who jump from airplanes and helicopters in working order. We are, of course, talking about the team of parachute jumpers, and the best one at that. Why Sky Magic? Because they show magic in the air. They have been accompanied by smoke and pyrotechnics during every jump.

Airborne Pyrotechnics - one of the best night show groups. British pilots, the father and the son Tim and Tom Dews in their Grob 109b motor gliders are going to give presentation in the sky. Their display is a majestic work of art, fire pyrotechnics and music.

Bölkow Bo 105 - The Bölkow Bo 105 helicopter is an absolute legend of aviation. The aerobatic show with smoke and pyrotechnics especially at night has had spectacular effects. A very experienced pilot-instructor Maciej Dominiak takes place behind the controls.

Marek Choim - a pilot by choice of heart. He is going to present you his art of flying behind the controls of his Extra 330SC aircraft, which had been designed to meet the challenges of top-level aerobatics. But this is not the end of attractions. The aircraft is additionally armed with a smoke generator and pyrotechnics. Could there be a better combination?

Paweł 'Lojak' Kozarzewski – a motoparagliding pilot, multiple representative and medallist of the Polish Motoparagliding National Team, currently the coach of the Qatar National Team in this sport. His achievements can serve as an example of how success can be achieved through determination and talent. Paweł loves flying upside down, which he will prove to us in Giżycko.

Flyboard&Motoparagliding - we will combine the three elements, water, air and fire. A day and night motoparaglider show combined with flyboard shows, making "live pylons" and spiced up with pyrotechnic effects is going to create a unique spectacle that will certainly impress every participant at the Giżycko Air Show.

Vilollades - a talented trio for violin and electric harp, playing well-known pieces of classical music in a modern edition, accompanied by hot air balloon burners. The violinists will play for you from the decks of floating balloons, all on the town beach in Giżycko!

The Basilica in Swieta Lipka hosts the XXXV Swieta Lipka Music Evenings. In addition, you can attend organ presentations. The organ is 18-voice, and was built between 1719 and 1721 by organ builder from Königsberg Jan Mosengel. He attached great importance to both the sound of the instrument and its exterior design, which is why you can still admire the organ's unusually elaborate prospectus with moving figures.

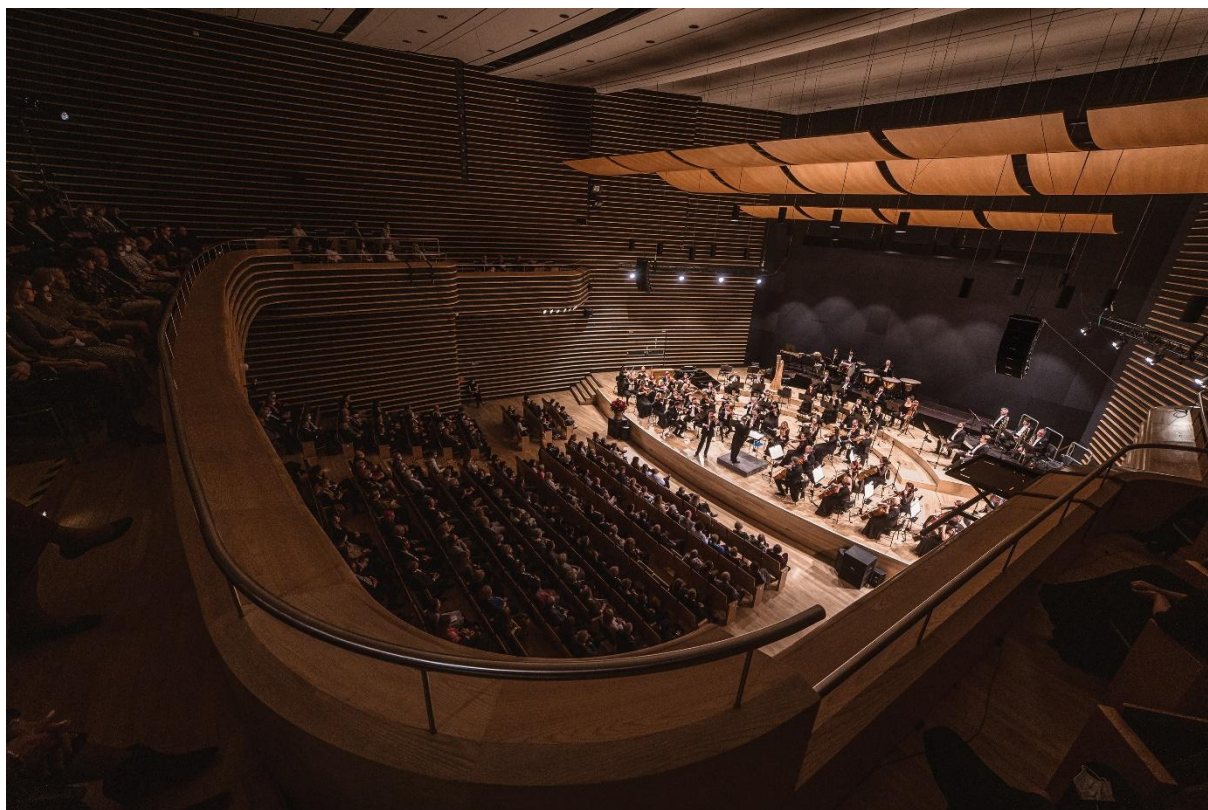
Paslek is home to the largest Baroque organ in northern Poland with a largely preserved original mechanism.

THE F. NOWOWIEJSKI PHILHARMONIC ORCHESTRA OF WARMIA AND MASURIA IN OLSZTYN

The F. Nowowiejski Philharmonic Orchestra of Warmia and Masuria in Olsztyn is the largest cultural institution in the Warmia-Masurian province. As such, it is the Philharmonic's responsibility to promote classical music, provide a variety of high culture events and education. The modern, impressive Philharmonic building is a place associated with elegance and prestige, a bright and recognizable point on the map of Olsztyn.

The new artistic season of the Warmia-Masuria Philharmonic promises to be very ambitious. The Olsztyn ensemble will play the great classics - the symphonies of Haydn, Brahms, Mahler, Berlioz, Franck, and even Beethoven's famous Symphony No. 9. It will also play the works that are less well-known, though of great interest, such as orchestral works by Henryk Wars, Aram Khachaturian, Leoš Janáček or the hit Concerto for Orchestra by Witold Lutoslawski, not heard in Olsztyn for a long time.

The 2023/2024 season in the Olsztyn Philharmonic will largely belong to the piano. For there will be many opportunities to listen to concerts for this

instrument: from Chopin and Schumann, through Brahms and Ravel, to the great, though forgotten Zygmunt Stojowski. There will also be concerts for violin (Mozart, Wieniawski, Szymanowski), trumpet (the excellent Gary Guthman in his own composition) or cello (Dvořák). Repertoire highlights include Henryk Wars' Urban Sketches, Aleksandr Tansman's ballet Bric-à-brac, a new work by Bartosz Smorągiewicz, Mikołaj Piotr Górecki's Paradise Lost or Valentin Silvestrov's The Messenger.

Separate events will certainly include a recital by pianist Janusz Olejniczak, New Year's Eve concerts conducted by a composer, arranger and conductor Tomasz Szymus, well-known not only to Olsztyn audiences, performances by the newly formed Warmia-Masuria Philharmonic Jazz Orchestra and an early music concert performed by the La Sensible ensemble.

The Olsztyn stage will feature outstanding conductors Paweł Przytocki, Marek Pijarowski, Mirosław Jacek Błaszczyk, Anna Sułkowska-Migoń, Wojciech Michniewski, Alexandr Iradyan, Pascual Osa and rising star Martyna Zych, who will be the resident conductor this season. Among the names of soloists, it is worth noting pianists Krzysztof Książek, Paweł Kowalski, Piotr Alexewicz, flutist Łukasz Długosz, violinists Piotr Pławner and Roksana Kwaśnikowska.

CHAMBER ENSEMBLE "PRO MUSICA ANTIQUA"

The chamber ensemble "Pro Musica Antiqua" was founded in September 1992. Leszek Szarzyński has been the founder and at the same time its artistic director and manager. He has gathered outstanding artists around him - soloists of symphony orchestras and professors of Academies of Music.

"Pro Musica Antiqua" has had a rich repertoire and has presented music of different epochs. The ensemble has promoted works by masters of the Baroque and early Classicism preferably. An important place in the ensemble's repertoire occupy works written especially for the ensemble by Marcin Błażewicz, Marian Sawa, Marek Sewen, Bernard Chmielarz, Marek Czerniewicz, Tadeusz Kassak, Lucjan Marzewski and other contemporary Polish composers.

The ensemble also has given active concerts abroad (Austria, Germany, Hungary, Lithuania, Sweden, France). It was honored with, among others, the "Atut '94" award and the "Golden Record" awarded by the DUX phonographic company.

In 1994 the ensemble Pro Musica Antiqua received the ATVT award, in 2006 the Special Award of the Minister of Culture and National Heritage in recognition of its contribution to Polish culture, and in 2007 the "Best of the Best" Award of the Marshal of the Province of Warmia and Masuria for promoting the Warmia and Mazury region in the world.
